A Word About Financial Aid at Davidson

The Davidson Trust meets 100 percent of calculated financial need with a combination of grants and student employment. Financial aid packages do not include a loan component for all on-time aid applicants. Of course, students and their families may still take out loans as a matter of personal financing.

Davidson College Wait List Frequently Asked Questions

How is the wait list determined?

Because of Davidson's small enrollment, the college is not able to admit many of the talented students who apply each year. We offer a place on the wait list to students whom we will welcome into the Davidson community if space becomes available.

Is there a set number of students whom Davidson will choose from the wait list?

No. The number of students admitted on April 1 who accept our offer to enroll determines our ability to use the wait list each year. In the last three years, the number of students who enrolled from the wait list is as follows:

	2017	2018	2019

Women	18	18	11

Is the wait list numbered or ranked?

No. Davidson reviews the credentials of all wait list candidates after response cards have been returned and openings have become available.

Should I submit additional information?

Yes! We encourage you to be in touch with additional academic information, such as third-quarter or second trimester grades. We also welcome updates on your activities out of class.

Should I deposit at another college, even though I want to attend Davidson?

Yes. No later than May 1, you should make an enrollment deposit at your next choice of college, one that most closely fits your academic and social needs. If Davidson or another college accepts you from its wait list, you will then decide if you wish to change your initial decision. It is your obligation and responsibility to promptly notify the college from which you wish to withdraw. Most colleges do not refund deposits when a student withdraws his or her place in the class.

How early might Davidson accept students from the wait list?

Depending on the number of deposits received, we may call to accept some students as early as the first week in May.

How late in the summer might a student be accepted at Davidson?

Historically, our wait list is closed by mid- to late-June. In some cases, a few students may be allowed to remain on the wait list beyond that point to be considered if that rare spot becomes available in July or August.

I am a candidate for financial aid. If accepted from the wait list, can I still be considered for financial aid?

Yes. Davidson's financial aid resources have historically allowed the college to offer admitted wait-list students aid packages consistent with those offered to students admitted at regular decision.

If I withdraw my financial aid application, are my chances of being accepted from the wait list improved?

No. Davidson is a need-blind college, and your admission decision is not influenced by your eligibility or need for financial assistance.

Should I plan to visit?

You are welcome to visit at any time, and we encourage you to visit if that would help you gauge your interest in attending Davidson if you are admitted from the wait list. The last day of classes falls on May 7.
