THE JOHN M. BELK SCHOLARSHIP

Annual Award Amount: Comprehensive cost (tuition, fees, room, and board) for eight semesters plus two \$3,000 special opportunity stipends.

Number Awarded: Up to eight in each first-year class.

Eligibility: Students who demonstrate exceptional achievement and promise in academics, character, leadership, and service.

NOMINATION PROCESS

- ◆ Each high school or community-based organization may nominate up to two students per year.
- ◆ Nominations must be submitted by December 1, 2022.

Nominees' application for admission to Davidson College is due by December 15, 2022.

BELK SCHOLARS ARE:

- ◆ Challenge seekers who embrace intellectual depth, academic achievement, and demonstrate accomplishment in meaningful activities.
- ◆ Intellectual explorers who exude eagerness to learn and strive to enrich their own and others' understanding.
- ◆ Servant leaders with confidence and humility, who collaborate and galvanize peers to meaningful action.
- ◆ Change agents who catalyze community improvement and make connections to bring about positive change.



THE BRYAN SCHOLARSHIP

Annual Award Amount: Full tuition and fees for eight semesters.

Number Awarded: Two Bryan Scholars (one female and one male) are named in each incoming class.

Eligibility: Participate in an eligible sport, be nominated by a counselor, school head, or coach. Must intend to continue competing in an eligible sport at the Division I level at Davidson. Must move forward with recruitment from Davidson coaches to progress in the Bryan selection process.

ELIGIBLE SPORTS

Men: Baseball, Cross Country, Indoor Track, Outdoor Track & Field, Soccer, Swimming & Diving, Tennis, Wrestling

Women: Cross Country, Field Hockey, Indoor Track, Lacrosse, Outdoor Track & Field, Soccer, Swimming & Diving, Tennis, Volleyball

NOMINATION PROCESS

- ◆ Counselor, school head, or coach (high school, league, or Davidson College) must nominate student(s) by **September 27** of their senior year.

- ◆ Nominees must submit the recruiting questionnaire and email stats and player profile information to the Davidson coach of their sport by **September 29**. Coach contact details can be found at www.davidsonwildcats.com.
- ◆ Nominees must apply for admission to Davidson by **October 14**. (Early date does not necessarily imply an Early Decision commitment.)
- ◆ Finalists will be notified ASAP; selection interviews will take place in early November.



ADDITIONAL **APPLICATION** SCHOLARSHIPS

JAMES B. DUKE AT DAVIDSON SCHOLARSHIP

- ◆ Full tuition and fees for eight semesters, plus a \$5,000 stipend to be used for applied, relevant learning experiences.
- ◆ Awarded to five high-achieving students in the first-year class whose academic achievement, concern for others, diverse talents and experience, potential for impact, resilience, and work ethic give evidence of their capacity to make a difference in the world.
- ◆ Application materials are due **January 11, 2023**.





CREATIVE ARTS SCHOLARSHIPS

PATRICIA CORNWELL CREATIVE WRITING SCHOLARSHIP

- ◆ \$35,000 annually for eight semesters. Awarded to a first-year student who demonstrates exceptional talent and passion for writing.
- ◆ Recipients are **NOT** required to major or minor in English.
- ◆ Application materials are due in alignment with your chosen application plan.

MUSIC SCHOLARSHIPS

- ◆ Up to \$15,000 annually for eight semesters. Awarded to a number of students who demonstrate exceptional talent and passion for music.
- ◆ Recipients are **NOT** required to major or minor in Music.
- ◆ All finalists will be offered free music lessons in their instrument for their four years at Davidson.
- ◆ Application materials are due in alignment with your chosen application plan.

PEPPER VISUAL ARTS SCHOLARSHIP

- ◆ \$15,000 annually for eight semesters. Awarded to a first-year student who demonstrates outstanding talent and promise in the field of visual art.
- ◆ Recipients are **NOT** required to major or minor in Art.
- ◆ Application materials are due in alignment with your chosen application plan.

WILLIAM HOLT TERRY SCHOLARSHIP

The William Holt Terry Scholarship is Davidson's preeminent leadership development award.

Applicants for admission to Davidson College are automatically considered for this award; no separate application materials are required.

This annually renewable scholarship is offered to those who have demonstrated extraordinary potential and ability to contribute to our vigorous living and learning community.

Candidates are identified by the Davidson Admission Committee, The Dean of Admission, and the Director of the Terry Program. Selection is based on holistic review and a finalist interview in March.

WILLIAM HOLT TERRY SCHOLARSHIP

- ◆ Full cost of attendance (tuition, fees, room, board, and books) annually, plus a \$5,000 special opportunity stipend.
- ◆ Awarded to two students in each first-year class.
- ◆ Recognizes students who demonstrate exemplary leadership skills, personal qualities, and a commitment to service.

GENERAL SCHOLARSHIPS INFORMATION

Scholarship consideration is based primarily on the strength of the student's application for admission, with additional consideration given to materials required for Additional Application Scholarships and/or interviews, where applicable.

Early Decision and Regular Decision candidates are considered equally for scholarship opportunities.

All scholarships are renewable for eight semesters, provided GPA, progress toward degree requirements, and award-specific requirements are met.
